Introduction

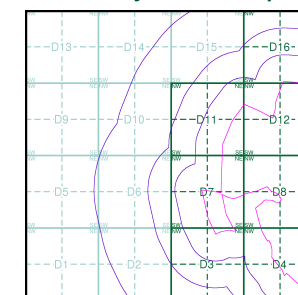

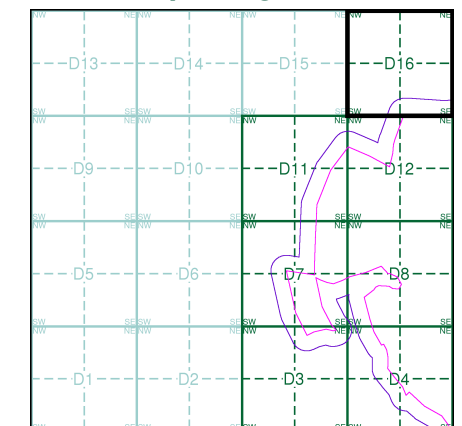
